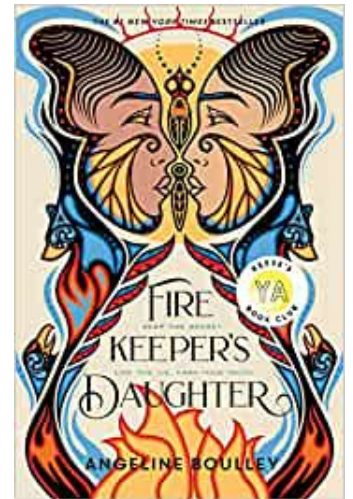

First time author, Angeline Boulley, breaks new ground with her first novel, "the Fire Keeper's Daughter". Set in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, the story encompasses a young indigenous woman's realization that the opioid crisis in her First Nation tribe is out of control and she must do something to stop it. Written in a simplistic style, Boulley includes many aspects and terms of indigenous culture probably unknown by most readers. Hailed by critics as a "must read" for teens, young adults, parents and grandparents, it is full of suspense as our young heroine turns informant to save her friends, family and tribe. 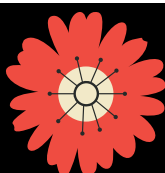

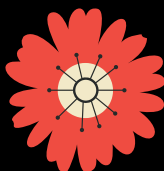
CANADA REMEMBERS TIMES - (Ages 12 to 18) This newspaper explores Canada's sacrifices and achievements in military effort over the years.
