

Wall Kimmerer cares for all of creation and was able to braid it all together by raising a family, teaching (professor) and fully engaging in her Indigenous culture and being.

An example from Braiding Sweetgrass that demonstrates this beautifully is the Three Sisters planting; corn, squash, beans. Corn grows tall to support the climbing beans and the squash shades it all. This is what we need to do to support one another in many different ways and be grateful.


New books should be published within the last 2 years. There is no timeline for classics.
